

Postdoctoral position - Lakehead University

We are excited to advertise a fully funded, 2-year, post-doctoral researcher position in the Department of Geology at Lakehead University. The postdoctoral researcher will investigate gold mineralization within the Shebandowan greenstone belt (Wawa subprovince of Northern Ontario) to constrain the regional tectonics and to characterize the mechanisms of gold mineralization / enrichment. We seek a candidate with a strong background in field geology (structural, metamorphic, mineral deposits, geochemistry, or geochronology) and some experience with microanalytical techniques (*any of the following*: SEM, TEM, EMPA, SIMS, LA-ICPMS). The project is funded through an NSERC Alliance grant with Goldshore Resources Corp. The postdoctoral researcher will be mentored by [Dr. Noah Phillips](#) and [Dr. Peter Hollings](#) and will work closely with 2 MSc candidates (providing the postdoc with significant mentoring experience). The start date is open, however, we are hoping the candidate will be able to participate in some field work this fall.
