

# Université Laval

We are excited to advertise a 2 year post-doctoral researcher position at the department of Geology and Geological Engineering of Université Laval in beautiful Quebec city, Canada. This full-time position is fully-funded for two years, starting as early as yesterday (!), and no later than march 2023.

We are looking for a candidate with demonstrated expertise in metamorphic petrology, petrochronology, isotopic geochemistry, and/or detrital geochronology. Ph.D. degree must have been awarded within 3 years from hiring (no earlier than October 2019).

The post-doctoral researchers will join a large team of over 40 graduate and post-graduate researchers revolving around the NSERC-Agnico-Eagle industrial research chair on mineral exploration, the Virginia-Gaumond chair in Tectonics, the E4m research center on mineral resources and the Laurentian University Metal Earth CFREF program.

The advertised position is funded through the Gold Fluid Window thematic project of the Metal Earth program (<https://merc.laurentian.ca/research/metal-earth>) in collaboration with the Quebec Geological Survey (MERN) and will involve research on the assembly of the Archean Superior Craton, with field work planned for the summer of 2023. Supervising committee includes Doug Tinkham at Laurentian University, Georges Beaudoin at Université Laval as well as Carl Guilmette from Université Laval as the main supervisor.

Applications must include a short cover letter, a detailed CV, a list of three referees, and should be sent to Pr. Carl Guilmette ([carl.guilmette@ggl.ulaval.ca](mailto:carl.guilmette@ggl.ulaval.ca)). Deadline for application is October 23<sup>rd</sup>.
