Senior Contaminated Sites Officer
\$83,247.83 - \$106,359.81 annually

The Senior Contaminated Sites Officer is a subject matter expert on the investigation and remediation of contaminated sites in BC. The position requires high-level skills and expertise in environmental engineering, geosciences, hydrogeology and soil science to conduct reviews and provide authoritative interpretation, advice, recommendations and decisions regarding the investigation and remediation of contaminated sites throughout the province.

This position is responsible for planning, coordination and implementation of appropriate studies and remediation strategies. The position leads and collaborates in developing legislation, regulation, policy and guidance related to the program's mandate and is critical to the achievement of priority goals and objectives including protection of human health and the environment.

Qualifications for this role include:

- Must be registered, or immediately eligible for registration, as a fully licensed Professional (Engineer, Geoscientist, Agrologist) member in good standing with the Association of Engineers and Geoscientists of BC (EGBC) or the British Columbia Institute of Agrologists (BCIA).
- Bachelor of science degree in engineering, geosciences, hydrogeology or agrology AND a minimum of seven (7) years of directly related experience; OR
- Graduate degree (Masters or Doctoral/Doctorate of Philosophy (Ph.D.)) in engineering, geosciences, hydrogeology or agrology AND a minimum of five (5) years of directly related experience.

Preference may be given to applicants with the following:

- At least ten (10) years of directly related experience obtained post-registration as a Professional Engineer, Geoscientist, or Agrologist.
- Experience working effectively, respectfully and knowledgeably with different levels of government and Indigenous communities.
